Upon graduation social and environmental research in Berlin, at the Free University and Science Centre Berlin, Germany. Since 1997 lecturer and researcher; since 2007 professor in human ecology at the School of Global Studies, Gothenburg University, Sweden. Since 2011 professor at the National Research University, Higher School of Economics, Department of Sociology, Moscow, Russia. Visiting professor at several universities (Free University of Brussels, Lomonosov State University Moscow, New University of Lisbon).

Main areas of teaching, research and publication: environmental sociology, environmental policy, natural resource use in agriculture and fisheries, coastal zone management, rural and urban sustainable development, environmental conflicts, human and social ecology.
